## **Principal Functions as Youth Pastor**

Support the ongoing ministry to high school and middle school students at Crossview Church by building positive relationships with youth and youth parents, modeling a Christ-like lifestyle and attitude, planning / leading / or assisting, as appropriate, at various ministry events that reinforce the Crossview vision, values, and mission.

## **Qualifications**

1. Salvation evidenced by written and oral testimony of commitment to Christ by profession of faith and believer’s baptism.
2. A deep and growing love for Jesus Christ and desire to serve him.
3. A lifestyle that reflects an authentic commitment to Christ, serving as a Christ-like example to all, and a commitment to conduct their private and public life with personal integrity, humility, and holiness.
4. Crossview Membership and personal investment in the life of Crossview, your Church Home.
5. Experience in successfully leading and growing youth groups
6. The ability to sense God’s call for the youth ministry and to cast a vision for this ministry.
7. Ability to manage time, complete assignments, and initiate/implement new ideas.
8. Ability to relate well with all members, especially the youth and their parents.
9. Theologically supportive of Crossview’s statement of basic beliefs as expressed in “The Baptist Faith and Message” (2000 edition).

## **Performance Reviews & Feedback**

Meet regularly with the Senior Pastor and Elders to:

1. Review the past month’s activities.
2. Receive feedback on performance and use the feedback to grow in personal ministry skills.
3. Provide suggestions to Senior Pastor based on observations and interactions with the students and congregation.
4. Agree on expectations for the upcoming months based on Crossview’s calendar of events.

## **Job Summary as Youth Pastor**

Use his or her set of skills, knowledge, interests, and passions to help direct, support and enhance the Crossview student ministry. The individual will report to the Senior Pastor and Elders in growing the Youth Ministry in areas of Outreach, Spiritual Discipleship, Service, Activities, and integration of our Youth into various other Ministries of the church for their Spiritual Growth and His use.

## **Responsibilities and Expectations as Youth Pastor**

The goal is to develop students who are increasing in their knowledge of God and His Word and are growing in their love for God and others.

**Weekly**

1. Sunday School – Teach the Senior High Sunday School and Middle High Sunday School class
2. Sunday Worship – Attend every week sitting with or otherwise engaging the youth
3. Youth Gathering – Lead regularly. Plan activities and teaching for the group
4. Follow up with youth prospects to evangelize or encourage continued participation in the ministry.

**Monthly or as scheduled**

1. Youth Activities and Special Events – Plan and Participate in youth activities and special events such as socials, outreach activities, ministry activities, and retreats. Co-ordinate the youth activities with the church calendar and be available for meetings as needed for co-ordination of activities involving the youth and the church.

**Annually**

1. Ensure that the youth are provided with appropriate opportunities for mission trips or camps.
2. Help develop Youth budget and administer Youth budget in accordance with financial policies.
3. Develop and communicate a vision for the youth ministry as lead by the Holy Spirit.

**Crossview Staff Responsibilities**

As a member of Crossview's Ministerial Staff, the Youth Pastor is expected to:

1. Have a positive working relationship with all leaders and members of the church body.
2. Enthusiastically represent Jesus Christ to the community.
3. Demonstrate an appropriate work ethic for ministers, including attendance, office hours, responding to communication (phone call, e-mails, etc), study, prayer, and service.
