Our Vision and Mission at Noonday Baptist Church

At Noonday Baptist Church, our vision is clear: "Knowing Christ and Making Him Known." This mission is to drive every aspect of our ministry as we seek to honor God in three primary ways:

1. Through Our Relationship with God

Worship is at the heart of our faith. Each of us is created to worship, and true worship flows from a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. It is through this connection that we express genuine love for God and experience His transforming presence.

2. Through Our Relationship with His Church

The Christian life is one of continual growth and service. We aim to equip believers with biblical principles that can be applied daily, helping them mature in their faith and serve actively within the church.

3. Through Our Relationship with the World

Our calling extends beyond the church walls. Noonday is committed to reaching those who are outside the family of God. Every interaction is an opportunity to share the hope of Christ, often just one invitation away from a life-changing encounter.

Our History and Faithful Foundation

Noonday Baptist Church was founded in June 1835, just about a mile from our current location in Marietta, Georgia. The 12 original members of Noonday were so moved by the grace of God in their lives that they felt compelled to join together to worship and share the Gospel in their community. Through the decades, God has been so very faithful as Noonday has faced and endured many hardships and challenges. After almost 190 years of ministry, Noonday stands today as a testimony of God's unending grace. We believe that He is still everfaithful as we face new challenges in this post-Covid era.

Ministries and Community Impact

Noonday Baptist Church is blessed with multiple ministries that reflect our mission:

- Children's Ministry: Our 2024 VBS welcomed a record attendance of 125 children, with 12 making decisions for Christ.
- Rooted Student Ministry: Engages an average of 25 middle and high school students.
- **Awana Program**: Serves 74 children with a growing outreach.
- **ESL & Citizenship Programs**: Welcoming 39 participants weekly.
- **Noonday Christian Academy**: Since 1970, our preschool has nurtured generations. Enrollment for 2024-2025 is 140 students.
- Unique Ministries: The Hands Held High Puppet Ministry touches lives through performances in our children's department, local assisted living communities, Noonday's Fall Festivals and Easter Outreaches, and through mission trips.

Other opportunities include weekly Bible studies for men and women, small groups, and our strong partnership with Kell High School's varsity football team, where we serve breakfast to over 100 athletes and coaches before each home game. Additionally, our Samaritan's Purse Christmas Shoebox project has sent over 300 boxes in 2024 alone, with a dedicated group crafting and organizing throughout the year.

Missions and Outreach

In 2024, we reaffirmed our commitment to Acts 1:8 and expanded our outreach:

- **Local and National Missions**: Students have traveled to Alabama, Tennessee, and Florida to serve and share the Gospel.
- **Global Missions**: Plans for 2025 include a church-wide Dominican Republic trip to partner with Word of Life and a puppet ministry outreach in Wisconsin. For over 20 years, we have partnered with Salt and Light Baptist Church in Haiti, supporting their VBS program, which welcomed 420 children in 2024, resulting in 37 new believers.
- A missions team has been recently been formed to establish and maintain identified missions
 commitments and activities, and to generate excitement and enthusiasm within the church.
 With this, our new missional statement was created.
- **Missional Statement**: "Walking in Obedience to the Great Commission: How Beautiful Are the Feet..." (Romans 10:15).

Noonday also continues to support Lottie Moon and Annie Armstrong offerings, as well as local and state associations.

Looking Ahead

Despite challenges, including a decrease in attendance from 216 (2019) to an average of 109 in worship services and the resignation of our senior pastor without provocation, God's faithfulness remains steadfast. With the sale of a portion of our property in 2023, we reduced debt from over \$3 million to \$130,000 and anticipate retiring the remainder within seven years.
